

## **The area around Southwark – Page 1**

This document is intended to be an adjunct to the pages on the web site about the area around Southwark.

The numbers on the maps are not intended to give an order of visiting but just to enable labelling. You decide on your own route. Underground stations are labelled in blue lettering and station entrances are marked with a blue square somewhere near the title. For example – on the first map near the centre of the top edge is the label for 'Bank' station with the blue block marking the entrance just below.

### **Key to the labels:**

1. City Hall.
2. Hay's Galleria.
3. HMS Belfast.
4. Southwark Cathedral.
5. Golden Hinde.
6. Winchester Palace ruins.
7. Shakespeare's Globe Theatre.
8. Tate Modern.
9. Millenium Bridge.
